<b>Objective 1</b>		
To improve the quality of curriculum time P.E teaching		
<u>Actions</u>	<u>Impact</u>	<u>Further Action needed</u>
<p>School Sports Mentor to work every year group to introduce new fitness test as well as ensure staff are proficient using the new assessment tracker.</p> <p>A new curriculum map adopted in September 2015 with a focus on skill acquisition and development.</p> <p>CPD to be offered where a need has been identified. P.E Staff Meetings to offer whole staff CPD.</p> <p>Resources to be regularly audited to ensure the correct equipment is available to teachers</p>	<p>*See Working with School Sports Mentor 2016/2017, school mentor evaluations and staff CPD</p>	
<b>Objective 2</b>		
To create greater engagement amongst less active / vulnerable / under represented		
<u>Actions</u>	<u>Actual Impact</u>	<u>Further Action needed</u>
<p>To set up a new Change4Life Club.</p> <p>Many children have expressed an interest in attending a running club. Lunchtime running club to be set up.</p> <p>Sports for Streets Initiative to run a club during Term 5.</p> <p>Different sports to be investigated and taster sessions / clubs arranged – with a specific focus on the less active / vulnerable.</p>		
<b>Objective 3</b>		
To ensure all children leaving KS2 have met the KS2 'standard' for swimming		
<u>Actions</u>	<u>Actual Impact</u>	<u>Further Action needed</u>
<p>Top up swimming sessions to continue.</p> <p>SS to attend a swimming course which will improve the quality of her swimming teaching and children's learning.</p> <p>Year 3 and 4 teachers to engage with parents of children who are finding swimming challenging.</p>

To increase participation in festivals, competitions and extra-curricular sport

To increase number of level 1 and level 2 competitions

<b><u>Actions</u></b>	<b><u>Actual Impact</u></b>	<b><u>Further Action needed</u></b>
<p>CW to work with SI to ensure maximum number of participants attend NOSSP events.</p> <p>KS leads take on greater responsibility for organising attendance at Level 2 competitions. In doing so, they will monitor which children are attending.</p> <p>Kidlington Partnership to add additional level 2 festivals for Year 3 and 4 children to increase participation.</p> <p>Each class to have at least three Level 1 competitions per year with the college system used to raise competition and enthusiasm. Mentor to work with class teachers to ensure this is happening.</p> <p>Where needed, transport to be provided to enable children to attend events.</p>
