

Summary of SEN Report to Governors 2017

Evaluation of Special Educational Needs Provision and Pupil Progress at year ending July 2017

Analysis of Numbers of Pupils on SEN Register

At present there are 49 pupils on the register (correct July 2017). This represents 11.6% of the 421 pupils on roll. National figures (July 2016) indicate 14.4% of the school population on the register. Our register is below the national average. There has been movement through the year both on and off the register. A number of pupils have made accelerated progress enabling removal from the register.

Analysis of SEN Pupils Progress

SEN children have done well this academic year, many having demonstrated accelerated progress in some areas.

Analysis of Approaches to Pupils' BESD (behavioural, emotional and social difficulties)

West Kidlington Primary School has always prided itself on the pastoral care offered to all its pupils. In the past few years the emotional needs of pupils has become more complex and new ways of supporting their needs have been set up in school. For the last few years ClearSky have been financed by school to provide play therapy for particular pupils with social and emotional health needs. The newly established Safeguarding Team has begun to work with specific pupils and their families. These interventions will be monitored and measured for impact.

Impact of White Horse Federation for SEN at West Kidlington (2017)

This year the system of measuring attainment and progress for our children has been changed to fall in line with that used by the White Horse Federation. The system for recording attainment for SEN pupils will be rationalised across the federation which will make outcomes for SEN pupils clearer when measured against the rest of the cohort.

Systems of assessment at three points through the year will enable the progress of the SEN cohort to be tracked consistently and effectively.
